

Job Posting – Wireless Internet, Field Technician

We require a Field Technician who will be responsible for installing and repairing wireless internet equipment for residences and businesses throughout the Peace Region.

Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Scheduling of site visits in conjunction with team administrators
- Installation of wireless radio's, routers and cables
- Maintaining and servicing access points and backhaul sites
- Testing wireless signal quality
- Maintaining appropriate equipment inventory levels
- Preparing installation reports
- Troubleshoot signal issues on the job and in the office
- Accurately diagnose and repair signal issues remotely and on site
- Prepare detailed site visit reports
- Providing top notch customer service to our members

Qualified candidates should demonstrate the following skills:

Technical Skills

- 1 Year technical certificate or diploma in a related field or a minimum of 1-year field experience
- A valid class 5 Drivers license (Air Brake license considered an asset)
- Fall Protection certificate (High Angle Rescue certificate considered an asset)

Other Skills

- Independence and initiative
- Problem solving
- Time management
- Skilled in conflict management
- Excellent verbal and written communications
- Eagerness to learn and innovate

Physical Skills

- Climb and work at elevations (e.g., from ladders, poles, lift trucks) exceeding 18 feet.
- Long periods of time sitting, walking, standing, stooping, bending, kneeling and squatting. Incumbent may be required to carry equipment weighing up to 30lbs for short distance.
- Work outdoors in different weather conditions (e.g., extreme cold and/or heat and inclement weather)
- Ability to work safely in hazardous environments or on hazardous road conditions
